Treasurer's Report – Secretary Jackson reviewed the 2025 checkbook ledger with attendees. Seventeen municipalities have paid their 2025 dues; three municipalities are outstanding. Follow-up notices will be sent. The March 31, 2025 balance is \$7,609.50. Motion by Peggy Kahler, seconded by Glenn Stoneroad to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion carried.

New Business

2024 Audit – Attendees reviewed the 2024 Audit Summary as prepared by Robyn Loesch. Secretary Jackson reported that two UDCOG members reviewed the supporting documentation for 2024 and agreed that everything was in proper order. Motion by Colby Snyder, seconded by Carole Wertz to accept the 2024 Audit Summary as presented. Motion carried.

Reimbursement for Train the Trainer Flagger Course – Millersburg Borough Public Works Crew Leader John Hoffman has agreed to take the training to become an instructor. Millersburg Borough is requesting reimbursement from COG to cover the expense of \$258.75, as invoiced from Associated Pennsylvania Constructors. Motion by Dennis Henninger, seconded by Carole Wertz to reimburse Millersburg Borough as requested. Motion carried.

Solicitor Appointment – Solicitor rates were requested from two firms. Stanley Laskowski with Caldwell & Kearns, P.C. quoted \$185 per hour. Joseph Kerwin with Kerwin & Kerwin, LLP quoted \$200 per hour. Motion by Carole Wertz, seconded by Colby Snyder to appoint Kerwin & Kerwin as UDCOG solicitor. Motion carried.

Jerry Duke announced that Chris Dietz has been named to the Dauphin County Planning Commission. Public comment will end at the end of August for the Regional Transportation Plan, which includes general transportation plans for Northern Dauphin County. The DCPC is also available to assist municipalities with land development and subdivision matters.

Don Shutt announced that Dauphin County will be sending out questionnaires about Three Mile Island, with reference to Emergency Management and the need to identify handicapped/bed-ridden individuals. Fallout shelters will also need to be identified.
